Age: I acknowledge that the minimum age requirement to begin flight training with ASU's flight provider is 18 years old.

Safety requirements: Student must be within limitations of the plane for the assigned flight. These limitations may vary based on aircraft but requires students to be below 250 lbs. in the Cessna 152 and Piper Seminole, and 300 lbs. for the Piper Archer. Student must be able to freely manipulate and operate all controls in the aircraft.

Permission to release your student information to flight provider: For Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) purposes, this signed form allows ASU to release your student information to the flight provider.

Additional financial requirements for the Professional Flight program to be paid to flight provider: In addition to required ASU tuition and fees, I understand that the Professional Flight program requires additional fees to be paid to the flight provider, that are, at minimum, approximately \$95,000. This amount is subject to change.

Requirements for completing flight training in the Professional Flight program at ASU: I acknowledge that upon entry to the Professional Flight program at ASU, all remaining flight training must be completed with ASU's flight provider.
